The current board of directors agreed to remain on the board for the next 2-year term with the membership unanimous approval at the March meeting.

**RECORDING, CORRESPONDENCE, TREASURY REPORTS:** Minutes of the board and general membership meetings including treasury reports are available upon request for the next three years.

**MEMBERSHIP:** As of March 22, 2022 CCW had 96 members plus 10 Honorary Lifetime Members. Member Terri Maffia passed since November 1921.

**EOY DONATIONS & AMOUNT CARRIED OVER:** CCW raised a record \$24,500. \$1800 each was donated to St Cecelia Inter-parochial School, Hope Villages of America, St Vincent de Paul Kitchen and Resource Center, St Brendan

Pinellas Hope Meals, St Brendan Virginia Tree and Pinellas Hope. \$1400 each was donated to Clothes to Kids, R'Club Child Care, St Peter Claver School, Joy to the Gospel Ministry, Clearwater Free Clinic, Helping People Help Themselves, Kimberly Home Pregnancy Resource Center and La Clinic Guadalapana. \$2049 was donated to St Brendan for a hold water dispenser, tablecloths and brochures describing the church windows. \$150 gifts each were given to the church's 3 staff members. CCW also sponsored a Blood Drive.
